

PAWS is Planning Something New!


But we are building one new structure: state-of-the-art housing for our PAWS Dogsin-Training!



Instead of one long row of kennels, our new Canine Village kennels will be grouped together in pods. These pods will be quieter, have their own dedicated entrances and exits to both the inside and outside, and can be opened up or closed off depending on our dogs' changing needs.



Based on decades of experience caring for PAWS Dogs-in-Training, we've worked with a team of architects to design a space that best meets the needs of our pups and the people who work with them. The designs include a centrally-located food prep area, an on-site exam room for basic health checks, and a dedicated laundry facility in the middle of the kennel pods.

In a first for PAWS, our new Canine Village will feature a special covered outdoor play yard, perfect for fun in all types of Michigan weather! Each kennel pod also features openings into standard outdoor yards, but we know this covered yard will be a favorite spot for PAWS Dogs for years to come.

Directly across the hall will be a brand-new grooming suite, which will be easily accessible for all our dogs to stay clean and healthy.
