3.	Local entries must be presented to an AMVET or Ladies Auxiliary representative on or before
4.	Department entries must be either hand-delivered with a return receipt from the Ladies Auxiliary Americanism Chairperson by April 1, 2025 or mailed to same and postmarked by April 1, 2025. Entries must have the completed, signed official Department Entry form attached.
5.	Entries must be on the template provided and may be colored using markers or crayons.
6.	Entries will be judged on each of the following categories: A. Use of template, or copy, provided B. Neatness C. Answers to questions
7.	Each entry <u>must</u> include the full name, birth date, address (including zip code), phone number, and grade of the student. The name, address and phone number of the parent or guardian must also be included. Please remember to indicate the name of the child's teacher and school affiliation.

8.	A written description of the entry, in 50 words or less , must be written on the back of the drawing. Descriptions that are firmly attached to the back of the poster will also be accepted.
